Scripture Sentences

Hear these words from Scripture

Matthew 28:18-20

All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, to the close of the age.

Ephesians 4:4-6

There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all and through all and in all.

Acts 2:39

The promise is to you and to your children and to all that are far off, every one whom the Lord our God calls.

Statement on the Meaning of Baptism

Obedying the word of our Lord Jesus Christ, and confident of his promises, we baptize those whom God has called. In baptism God claims us, and seals us to show that we belong to God. God frees us from sin and death, uniting us with Jesus Christ in his death and resurrection. By water and the Holy Spirit, we are made members of the church, the body of Christ, and joined to Christ's ministry of love, peace, and justice. Let us remember with joy our own baptism, as we celebrate this sacrament.

Relying on God's grace, do you promise to live the Christian faith and to teach that faith to your child?



Question to the Congregation

Do you as members of the church of Jesus Christ, promise to guide and nurture James by word and deed, with love and prayer, encouraging him to know and to follow Christ and to be a faithful member of his church?
