Call to Reconciliation

Logically, rationally, we have no need to confess. Our petty sins pale in comparison to the great evils of our time. But this is the day God tossed logic out the window and raised Jesus from the dead. So we must throw out our claims of innocence, and confess how we have not lived as God's Easter people.

You do not hand us over to death, but raise us to new life, through Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior, in whose name we pray.
