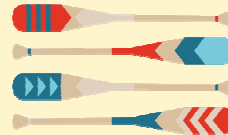
In the **Recreation Station** we played Pool Noodle Croquet and other fun games!

Clean Water for communities Camp El Guacio in Puerto Rico



El Guacio is a Presbyterian camp and conference center in San Sebastián, Puerto Rico. It was founded by missionaries as a medical dispensary for the impoverished rural community. It sits on over 80 acres and has a training program where participants have learned to farm and to craft exotic bamboo. The camp was on track to revive its bamboo workshop until Hurricane Maria destroyed the 13-acre crop.

Despite the setback, El Guacio has provided help and hope to victims of the hurricane. El Guacio is adjacent to Las Marías, a small town that lost its last supermarket in the storm. The town has been lacking food and water since the hurricane, so El Guacio opened its facility for people to access the only **clean water** available for miles of mountainous terrain. Unfortunately, El Guacio's own well system was damaged recently and their water supply and ability to help their neighboring poor is gone.

**A little goes

We can help. **Park Lake's Vacation Bible School** this week will talk about the importance of clean water for our bodies and communities. We will talk about serving God by serving our neighbors, particularly those in need.
