

### **Duties of Elders:**

- 1. Strengthen and nurture the faith and life of the congregation through regular attendance at worship.
- 2. Encourage the people in the worship and service of God.
- 3. Equip and renew the people for tasks within the church which fulfill the mission of the church.
- 4. Visit, comfort, and care for the people, with special attention to the sick, lonely, poor and any who may be in distress.
- 5. Serve as representative to the Presbytery and the General Assembly, if appointed.
- 6. Inform the minister(s) and the Session of those persons and structures within the church which may need special attention.
- 7. Perform those duties which all Christians are bound to discharge as responsible members of the church.
