### *“A Responsibility of the Congregation”*

We need to elect seven willing, dedicated people. You can be of great assistance in our selection by praying for this committee and recommending individuals for these positions. List nominations for Elder on the bottom of this form and place in the offering plate or return to the church office.



Members of the congregation play an important role in this process. You have the opportunity, even the duty, to submit names of members you believe should be considered. Any communing member, man or woman, any age, is eligible. Elders should be of faith, dedication and good judgment. Their manner of life should be a demonstration of the Christian gospel both within the church and in the world.

#### Duties of Elders:

1. Strengthen and nurture the faith and life of the congregation through regular attendance at worship.
2. Encourage the people in the worship and service of God.
3. Equip and renew the people for tasks within the church which fulfill the mission of the church.
4. Visit, comfort, and care for the people, with special attention to the sick, lonely, poor and any who may be in distress.
5. Serve as representative to the Presbytery and the General Assembly, if appointed.
6. Inform the minister(s) and the Session of those persons and structures within the church which may need special attention.
7. Perform those duties which all Christians are bound to discharge as responsible members of the church.
