May Ushers are Shawn Moloney, Mike Bookhardt, Bob Larr, Larry Welker and Eric Wood.

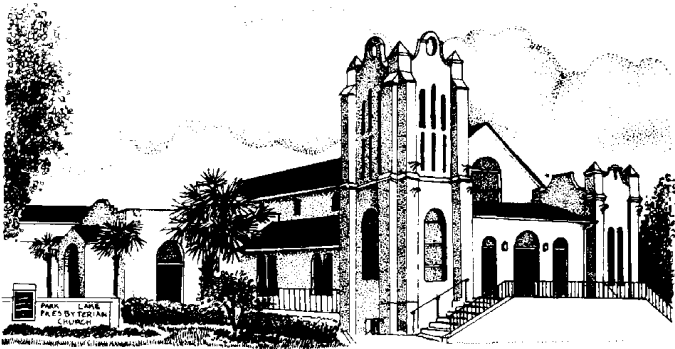

New Hymnal Dedications

We are using new hymnals in worship today.

Glory to God is the new Presbyterian hymnal, published in 2013. It contains 853 hymns, psalms, and songs. About 400 hymns are carried over from the 1990 blue hymnal—including most of the hymns we sing at Park Lake. There are more than 450 new hymns that come from older Presbyterian hymnals, other songbooks, and individual composers and authors. Glory to God includes a complete Psalter of singable Psalms and enough music for a complete Taizé service. There are liturgical texts to serve as a model for Reformed worship, and a brief note is included with each hymn, providing information about its music, theology, or history. Glory to God reflects the diversity of the church, incorporating many different musical styles: traditional, spirituals, folk, gospel, jazz, contemporary, and global music are all well-represented. Digital and projection versions are also available.

You can donate a new hymnal(s) for \$20 per hymnal.
