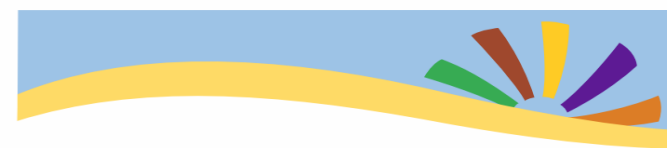
School Pantry Project • Christian Service Center

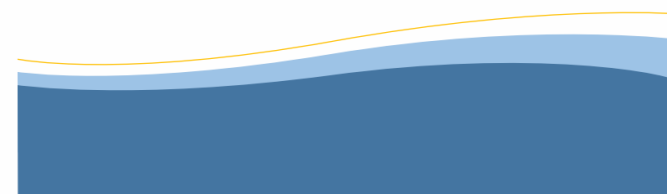
