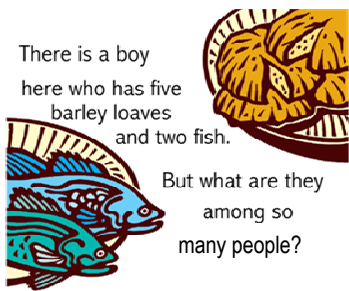
There will be a **Stated Session Meeting** after Worship, today, Sunday, October 27, in Struble Fellowship Hall.
