For 18 years our Hopeful Harvest event has provided families living in poverty a hand-up with their family meal for Thanksgiving. At this event, our members contribute \$5 to receive a 10-pound turkey and all the yummy side dishes for their family to share in the holiday. This provides struggling families with a dignified way to enjoy a full traditional meal and makes their holiday a little brighter.

450 families pre-registered for this event and on Monday, November 25, we were able to provide meals to 1,850 people, 700 of whom were children, in a community-centered, dignified manner. Through local food drives from generous supporters and partners we were able to collect over 6,300 items to distribute to families in need.

During the holiday season, families who are already stretched thin financially every day are often overwhelmed with additional stress. Programs such as Hopeful Harvest ensure these families have hope for the holidays. **The \$200 gift you recently made helps UP Orlando to continue a variety of programs that help families move forward in their deepest time of need, and we cannot thank you enough for your kindness.**
