at Park Lake!

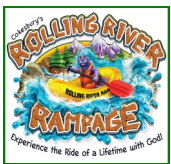
We are not able to meet in person,

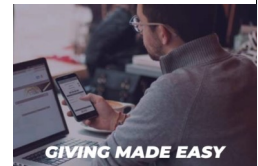
