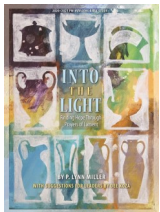

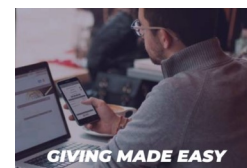

In the past months, I have pulled weeds, laid sod, replanted a small bed, weeded, trimmed and cut back plants and my favorite – spread mulch.
