SEPTEMBER STATED SESSION MEETING

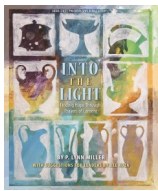

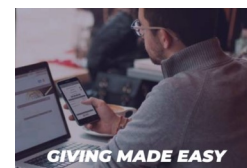
