The Sanctuary flowers this day, are given to the glory of God, by Robb Ross and Ryan Trapp in celebration of their wedding anniversary, on October 28th.

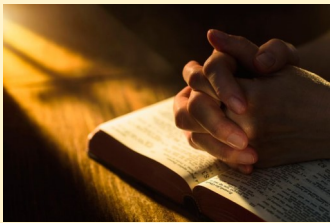

- **Pre-registration for worship attendance each week**

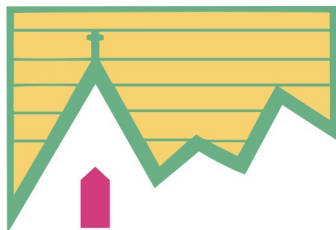
As we resume in-person worship we will follow all appropriate health guidelines.
