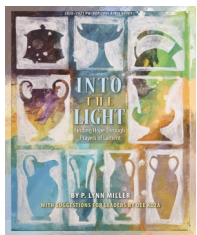


Church Chat

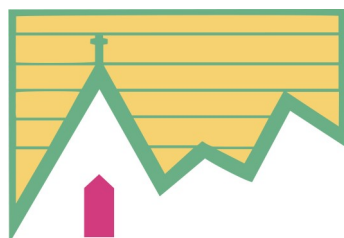

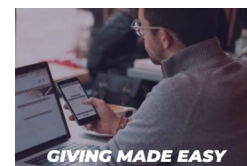
