Lent is a season of repentance and renewal of our faith. Lent begins with SDAY Ash Wednesday on which we remember with prayer, and with the tangible

commemorates the 40 days of Jesus fasting and praying in the desert at the beginning of his public ministry, as told in the synoptic gospels.
