VBS Update



Today, the Adventurers learned the **Bible story** about Moses and the Burning Bush, Exodus 3:1-20.

In the **PreK-4 class,** we took off our shoes, as we were on Holy Ground as we listened to the story of Moses and the Burning Bush. We put "flames" on a green bush. Our craft was using colorful tissue papers to make a burning bush picture.

In the craft room, the older groups created a sand art burning bush picture.

In Science, we learned about light, and the difference between light from a flashlight and light from a laser pointer. We learned that with some dry ice

you can see the laser light beam traveling through the dry ice fog, but can't see it traveling through air. It worked pretty well and the kids were really interested in the dry ice.

Our snack was a burning bush on a cracker with vegetable chips.

In Recreation, we were Shepherds hurdling "sheep" home, we played relay with hula hoops, balls and pool noodles. We were statues in the garden using our Bible story characters and of course *Sheep, Sheep, Shepherd* (aka, Duck, Duck, Goose).

The aftercare kids are making lighthouses out of recycled materials and played on the playground.
