VBS Update

Today, the Adventurers learned the Bible story about four friends helping their friend who was sick (Luke 5:17-26).

In the **PreK-4 class**, we colored the Discovery on Adventure Island coloring page that was attached to our craft bags. We made a foam lantern today. We played a game called 'stuck like glue', we learned the Bible Story of friends being helpful and having great faith.

In the **craft room**, we finished our sand art pictures from Tuesday. We made 3-D paper lanterns reminding us about our Signal verse, *Arise! Shine! Your light has come: the Lord's glory has shone upon you! (Isaiah 60:1).*
