

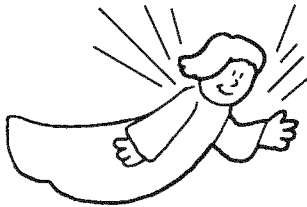

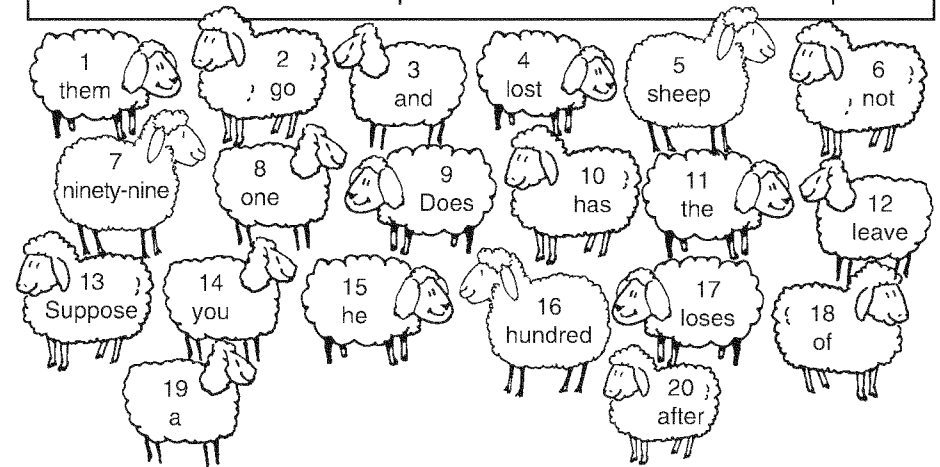

Write the words from the sheep on the lines below to read the first parable.

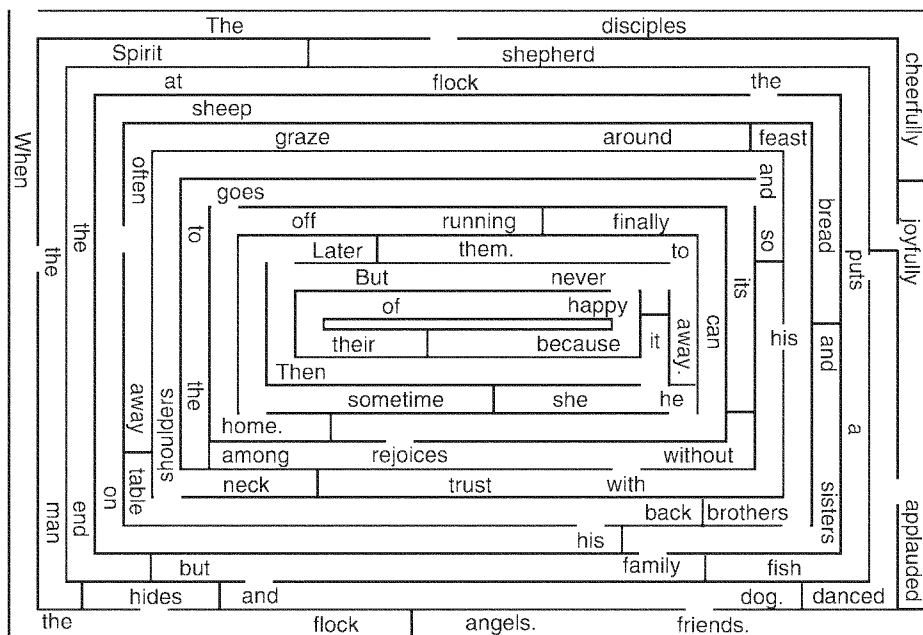
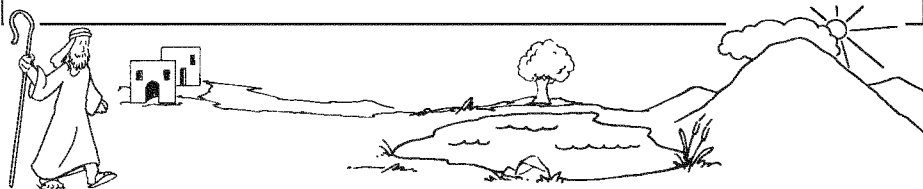
