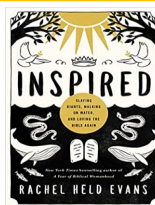

1. Please donate your unused coupons for groceries and sundries to the Russell Home for Atypical Children. The home has a special volunteer, called the "coupon lady" who clips coupons for items they need and saves them a great deal of money. Publix and some other stores will accept even the expired coupons.

2. Save your pop tabs from cans for Ronald McDonald House Charities.

As you may know, Ronald McDonald Houses provide a home away from home for families with children receiving treatment at hospitals and medical facilities in the area. They have a partnership with a recycling company that pays them for the tabs collected. many, many groups---churches, schools, scouts---collect these tabs so they quickly add up---to pounds converted to cash!

There are now 2 plastic bins labeled for these collections in the church office workroom. (You may give them to me, Anne Gardepe, as well, or leave them in the west transept and I will collect them)
