Financial Giving Directly from your IRA

If you are 70½ or older you can donate up to \$100,000 per year from your IRA. Call your IRA provider and request a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) check payable to Park Lake Presbyterian Church. Have the check mailed to you to put in the offering plate or mailed to the church at 309 East Colonial Drive Orlando, Florida 32801 attention Financial Administrator.



The QCD is not deductible; however, it is <u>excluded from taxable income</u>, which <u>reduces your adjusted gross</u> <u>income (AGI)</u>. AGI affects Social Security benefits and Medicare premiums. You do not have to itemize to make a QCD donation. If you are 72 or older, the charitable distribution can count toward your Required Minimum Distribution.
