Use the code to find the answer.



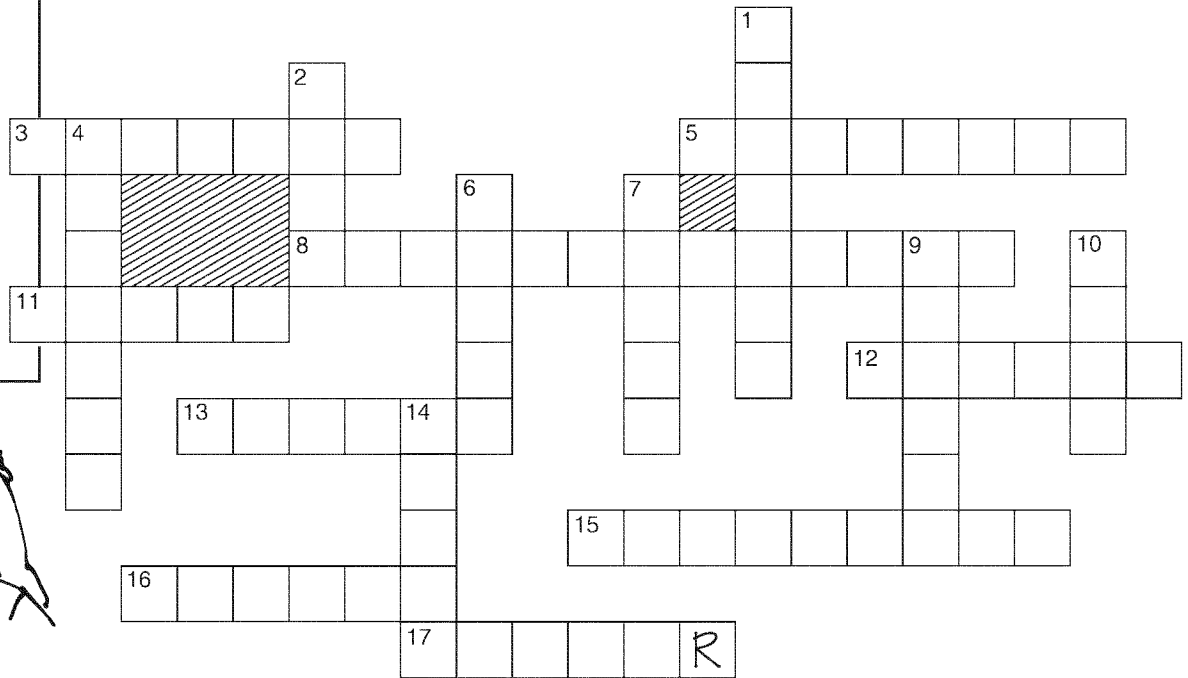
