# **Lenten Season 2023**

The season of Lent begins on Wednesday, **February 22**, with the observance of Ash Wednesday, concluding with Holy Week which begins with Palm Sunday, this year observed on **Sunday, April 2**. Lent predates Advent as a time of preparation, a time of turning our hearts and lives to consider the saving work of Jesus to reconcile the world to God. Lent is the

40 day journey culminating in Good Friday, or God's Friday, when Jesus takes on all the brokenness that humanity's sin has created. His life for our lives, Jesus dies on the cross.
