

### **About the Annual PW Birthday Offering**

Each year the Presbyterian Women of Park Lake, or PW for short, celebrates the birthday of the national PW organization which includes a birthday offering. This tradition started in 1922 when Hallie Paxson Winsborough challenged members of the Woman's Auxiliary of the Presbyterian Church in the US to give a penny for each year of her life as a birthday gift to celebrate the 10th anniversary of the organization. So, for 101 years Presbyterian Women have received this offering and helped provide transformative grants to worthy projects around the world. This year's recipients are the Making Miracles Group Home in Tallahassee which helps young mothers break the cycle of abusive relationships, addiction, incarceration, and early motherhood. The money they receive will go toward expansion to serve additional at-risk families. The second recipient is Berhane Yesus Elementary School in Dembi Dollo, Ethiopia which is the first entry point to education for children of subsistence farmers, migrant workers and displaced groups of people. They will use their grant for construction of a muchneeded kindergarten classroom.
