Bread for the World: Have Faith - End Hunger

Sunday, May 26, 2024

Put your faith into action with Bread for the World's Offering of Letters. Park Lake has long supported Bread for the World, a Christian advocacy organization dedicated to ending hunger by urging our elected leaders to advance appropriate policies and programs.

One of its key advocacy initiatives is encouraging our legislators to reauthorize the Farm Bill, which is slated to expire on September 20, 2024, after an extension in 2018 kept such provisions as SNAP and other key elements operating. You can visit **Bread.org/OL** for more information on the Farm Bill, which tackles childhood hunger, climate change, food waste, Food for Peace, and other issues.

We ask you to contact your U.S. Senators and Representatives to urge them to support and pass the Farm Bill by calling 800-826-3688 (Congressional switchboard) and writing a letter. You can find a sample letter at Bread.org/OL. We encourage you to bring your letters to church next Sunday or to the church office to be handdelivered.

Please also consider asking U.S. Sens. Rick Scott and Marco Rubio to help pass the Child Tax Credit bill, which would expand benefits for 16 million children from low-income families. It has passed in the House but is stalled in the Senate.
